The Education Department, Government of Gujarat has launched a unique policy known as Student Start-up and Innovation Policy (SSIP) for a large pool of students across Universities and Institutes to develop and nurture their potential for innovation and entrepreneurship.

During the first phase of the SSIP policy, students from our institute participated and received funds to develop their innovative ideas as proof of concept (PoC). The two projects undertaken were also put up for patent filing and are under process.

The second phase of the policy known as SSIP 2.0 has now been implemented and the Institute has received substantial funds to encourage ideation to PoC process amongst students. Students are encouraged to come up with new ideas / ideas to modify existing products or come up with innovative ideas to be supported financially for developing it further as a proof of concept.

A scrutiny committee shall select student proposals and selected proposals may be funded upto Rs. 2,50,000.00 (Rupees Two lakhs and fifty thousand). If the idea is patentable, then patent application cost will also be taken up by the institute at a maximum of Rs 75,000.00 per concept/project.

Sir P. T. Sarvajanik College of Science invites proposals from students for presenting their ideas. Ideas that are selected by the scrutiny team will be provided funds for creating / making/ designing proof of concept (PoC) as per rules of the SSIP Gujarat committee.
